### **iCommunity**



### Beaumanor Estate blooms with new community garden!

Exciting news for Beaumanor residents! A once forgotten corner of the Beaumanor Estate is being transformed into a vibrant community garden. The "Tap Water" project, led by Creative Futures, promises to bring a burst of life and creativity to our neighbourhood.

- A green oasis: Imagine a place where neighbours can gather, grow fresh produce, and enjoy the outdoors. This garden will be just that a green oasis right in our backyard.
- **Creative hub:** A dedicated shed for handcrafts will offer a space for residents to learn new skills, share their talents, and connect with each other.
- Location, location: With Ellis Fields, the Grand Union Canal, and Abbey Park just a short stroll away, this new garden will be a natural extension of the green spaces that make our neighbourhood so special. Imagine a leisurely walk down the canal, ending with a visit to the garden to relax or participate in a workshop.

"Tap Water" is still a work in progress, but there are lots of exciting things coming. Watch this space for updates on how you can get involved and make this community garden your own.

### Let's Talk!

Are you aware of the support we offer through our Let's Talk campaign?

- Affordable warmth: The team can help tenants who are struggling due to energy debt or problems with their energy bills. They can advise and assist vulnerable customers who are struggling to heat their homes.
- Money advice: Our team can help with Benefit claims and how to maximise your income.
- Employment and training: Provides information, advice and guidance to customers who are looking for work, or who are working but want to improve their career and increase their household income.



#### Spotlight on success

One of our residents - 'Mr B' - had been struggling with unemployment and mental health challenges due to a recent injury. Our dedicated Housing Officer worked with Mr B to create a plan and connected him with our Employment & Training team. Within just four weeks, Mr B had landed a new job and was on his way to a brighter future!

In another case, 'Miss T' was referred to the money advice team as she was facing financial hardship. Miss T was in high rent arrears facing court action and was at risk of losing her tenancy. Our Officers applied for a Discretionary Housing Payment (DHP) back date which was awarded, this reduced her rent arrears by over £1000.00. Miss T has since made a payment plan to reduce the remaining arrears on her rent account and has managed to sustain her tenancy as well as avoid court action in the process. These are just two examples of how Riverside is committed to supporting our tenants' well-being.
